

JEE (Advanced) 2017

For Admission to Undergraduate Programs at Indian Institutes of Technology

EXAMINATION

The Joint Entrance Examination (Advanced) forms the basis for admission to the following programs in Engineering, Science, Architecture and Pharmaceutics in various IITs:

- 4-year Bachelors: B.Tech., B.S., B.Pharm.
- 5-year Bachelors: B.Arch.
- 5-year Dual Degree: B.Tech.-M.Tech., B.S.-M.S.
- 5-year Integrated Masters: M.Tech., M.Sc., M.Pharm Dual Degree.

JEE (Advanced) 2017 will have two papers. Both the papers are compulsory. Each paper is of 3 hour duration and has objective type questions in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. The question papers will be either in English or in Hindi. Candidates have to exercise the choice of question paper language at the time of registration. JEE (Advanced) 2017 is being organized by IIT Madras.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must fulfill each of the following five criteria for appearing in JEE (Advanced) 2017:

1. Should be among the top 2,20,000 (all categories included) in JEE (Main) 2017.
2. Should be born on or after October 1, 1992. Five years relaxation is given to SC, ST and PwD candidates.
3. Should NOT have appeared in JEE (Advanced) in 2015 or earlier.
4. Should have appeared in Class XII (or equivalent) examination for the first time in 2016 or 2017. Candidates who wrote Class XII in 2015 are eligible if result was declared after June 2015.
5. Should NOT have accepted admission at any of the IITs earlier.

RESERVATION

Reservations are provided to Indian Nationals belonging to certain categories in accordance with the rules of the Government of India and such candidates are declared as qualified in JEE (Advanced) 2017 based on relaxed norms.

ADMISSION

Candidates qualified in JEE (Advanced) 2017 will be eligible for admission to the above mentioned academic programs at IITs subject to satisfying at least one of the following two criteria:

1. Must have secured at least 75% aggregate marks in the Class XII (or equivalent) examination. The aggregate marks for SC, ST and PwD candidates should be at least 65%.
2. Must be within the category-wise top 20 percentile of successful candidates in their respective Class XII (or equivalent) examinations.

Candidates who are eligible for admission will have to participate in joint seat allocation process by filling in their choices of the programs. The schedule of the joint seat allocation will be announced by the Joint Seat Allocation Authority (JoSAA) 2017.

EXAMINATION CENTRES

JEE (Advanced) 2017 will be held in select cities and towns in India across seven zones and in a few foreign countries. Every candidate should compulsorily choose three cities / towns from a zone of his / her choice at the time of online registration.

REGISTRATION

Candidates declared eligible to appear in JEE (Advanced) 2017 must register online at the JEE (Advanced) web portal by uploading the requisite documents and by paying the registration fee as detailed below:

Examination Fee for Centres in India
