Additional Information for Foreign Candidates

This information is meant for foreign candidates only

1. WHO CAN APPLY?

Candidates who are **NOT** citizens of India (by birth or naturalized), do not belong to OCI category, and whose parents are not citizens of India and do not come under OCI category at the time of registering for JEE (Advanced) 2017 are treated as foreign nationals. Seats allotted to foreign nationals are supernumerary with a cap of 10% of total number of seats in every course.

Foreign nationals are outside the ambit of reservation of seats under the OBC-NCL, SC, ST and PwD categories as mandated by Govt. of India.

These candidates are not required to write JEE(MAIN) and may register for JEE(Adv) 2017 directly subject to fulfilment of other eligibility criteria.

Identity Proof: Identity proof of both the parents is required in the form of citizenship certificate/Passport

ID Proof:

Identity proof of both the parents of the candidate is required.

2. AGE RELAXATION

In countries where a minimum stint in the armed forces (or allied) for a certain period is mandatory before/after Class XII (or equivalent) exam, the candidate will be given a relaxation of required number of years. In such cases, the candidate is required to upload a certificate/testimonial issued by competent authority to this effect at the time of registration.

4. PERFORMANCE IN CLASS XII (OR EQUIVALENT) BOARD EXAMINATION

The candidates must have secured at least 75% aggregate marks in the Class XII (or equivalent) board examination. If a Board awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the equivalent marks and submit it at the time

of acceptance of the allocated seat. In case such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by the Joint Implementation Committee of JEE (Adv) 2017 will be final.

5. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

- Birth certificate for age proof
- Class XII mark sheet/certificate for 75% cut-off
- Identity proof of the candidate
- Citizenship certificate/Passport of both the parents
- Testimonial (if required)

6. FOREIGN CENTRES WHERE JEE (ADV) 2017 WILL BE HELD

Addis Ababa (**Ethiopia**), Colombo (**Sri Lanka**), Dhaka (**Bangladesh**), Dubai (**UAE**), Kathmandu (**Nepal**) and **Singapore**.

7. ONLINE DISPLAY OF ORS AND ANSWER KEYS

In case of perceived discrepancy in the Objective Response Sheet (ORS), candidates can seek review of the machine-read responses. The requests should be submitted online with a review-fee at the rate of 20 USD per question to be reviewed. Detailed instructions and the mode of payment will be provided on the online portal.

8. ARCHITECTURE APTITUDE TEST FOR B.ARCH. PROGRAM

Successful foreign candidates, if interested in B. Arch. Program, are required to come to one of the Zonal IITs to write the test.
